


14 Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") makes the following response to
15 the Second Data Request of Commission Staff:

16 Data Request No. 1. Refer to the Response to Question 5 of the Commission
17 Staff's First Data Request dated April 14, 2005. Provide an update of the status of
18 obtaining the necessary creditor approvals required to continue the proposed revenue
19 reduction. Include the number of approvals received, the number of approvals not yet
20 received, and an estimate of when Big Rivers expects to receive the remaining approvals.

21 Response: The last of the necessary Big Rivers creditor approvals required to
22 continue the proposed revenue reduction was received by Big Rivers on July 11, 2005.
23 Because the person to whom the approval letter was addressed was out of town until July
24 12, 2005, Big Rivers did not have an opportunity to notify the Commission that the last of
25 the creditor approvals had been received prior to the time the Commission issued its
26 Second Data Request.
