On September 21, 2005, Complainant filed a motion with the Commission requesting that the discovery period and the hearing date be extended by no less than 14 days. 
The Commission finds that, because of Complainant's request for an extension of time and the subsequent negotiations between the parties, the procedural schedule in this case should be suspended generally.
