
Dear Mr. Johnson;

I am writing to request that KU/LGE/E-ON hold another information meeting on the planned transmission line that extends from Mill Creek to Elizabethtown. I am an affected property owner and do not feel like the strategically planned open house forum adequately answered all of the property owners questions. I am requesting that another meeting be held in the question and answer format so that we can get the information we need to make intelligent decisions with regard to our loss of property, wildlife, wetland habitat, etc. etc. We need an open question forum with direct and adequate answers, not just a "We Understand" response.

I would like for you to schedule this meeting ASAP with all of the affected landowners in the corridor that runs from the Hardin County Substation to Fort Knox. We need to see first hand just how many families are going to be affected by this so we need to be all grouped together to accomplish this. Please select an adequate sized facility where everyone can be seated in an orderly manner in the Elizabethtown area. Please send out notices to all of the property owners as well as posting it in the local newspaper so our neighbors also have a chance to voice their concerns. This just does not affect the property owners, it affects the whole community. How would you like to find out that a Transmission Tower was going to be in your back yard?
