Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

I am writing on behalf of Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (collectively the "Companies") to provide comments on the Intra-Agency Memorandum ("Memo") regarding the informal conference held at the Commission's office on October 4, 2005 in the above-referenced matters.

With regard to the first and second full paragraphs on page 2 of the Memo, the Companies wish to clarify that there was also discussion at the informal conference regarding the fact that some property-specific factors (such as geological issues) may not be known to the Companies, and that some landowner concerns might not be raised, until after an application has been filed or, perhaps, even after a CCN has been granted. As discussed at the conference, those issues are additional reasons that the Companies believe some flexibility should be granted to make adjustments to a line, including to the centerline, after a CCN is granted so long as those adjustments do not cause the line or right-of-way to be moved onto the property of another landowner.
