ATTORNEY GENERAL'S MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLY WITH THE COMMISSION'S ORDER
DATED 22ND JUNE 2005

Comes now the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention, and moves the Public Service Commission for an extension of time to respond to the Commission's order dated 22nd June 2005. Specifically, the order requires "any additional comments or requests for a hearing shall be filed with the Commission on or before August 15, 2005."¹ This motion is made on the following grounds.


In the Commission's order dated 22 June 2005 opening this docket, the Commission asked ten data requests and the Attorney General was granted leave to have the companies respond to two additional data requests. Given the approximately 500 companies involved, the responsive materials include around a thousand pages of information as well as various CDs, banners, pictures and other medium. Significant time is needed to review and analyze the discovery. Moreover, this is but one of many cases consuming the time and resources of the Attorney General's staff. Notwithstanding the undersigned's attempts to accomplish the task prior to August 15th,

additional time is required. Accordingly, the Attorney General hereby moves for three additional weeks, up to 5 September 2005, in order to comply with the Commission's order.

WHEREFORE, the Attorney General respectfully moves the Commission for an extension of time of three weeks, up to September 5, in which to comply with the Commission's order of 22nd June 2005.


