**RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE AND A MOTION
FOR EMERGENCY RELIEF FOR ELECTRICITY**

Comes now Walter Callihan and Goldie Callihan, herein and after referred to as Walter and Goldie, and hereby file their response to Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation's, herein and after referred to as GRECC, Motion as set out herein below:

The Plaintiffs emphatically object to a continuance for more than four days from December 2nd, 2005.

Walter and Goldie hereby file their Motion for an emergency hardship relief whereby the Kentucky Public Service Commission, herein and after referred to as the KPSC, orders GRECC to restore Walter's and Goldie's electrical service without any new application for service and

under the same status that the power was discontinued under without the condition whereby GRECC alleged Walter and Goldie owed GRECC a delinquent electric bill.

Walter and Goldie are not requesting service whereby they are stating that they can not afford to pay a new current monthly bill. They hereby state that they are able and have the funds in cash in hand to pay any current electric bill for their three meters. Under Federal and State Law, after the first of December a utility can not discontinue service until April first. Since that is the law, the same law would apply whereby the KPSC can order GRECC to restore the electrical power under same current law. Goldie is already sick, near pneumonia because of the cold house where she is now living.

The winter of the 2003 and 2004 invited the Callihans to file a formal Complaint against GRECC and the KPSC would most certainly order GRECC to turn the electrical power on under the conditions just referred to above.


And for all the reasons stated above Walter and Goldie demand the KPSC orders GRECC to restore said power forthwith.

There is a Motion now before the KPSC from Walter and Goldie with an Affidavit that states they can not receive a fair trial or hearing before the current KPSC and it's staff. Said Motion has been pending for months. The KPSC has ignored said Motion. Walter and Goldie demand that the KPSC rules upon that Motion forthwith.
