<u>ORDER</u>

Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Grayson RECC") has moved for an extension of time to respond to a Commission Staff discovery request and for rescheduling of the hearing in this matter. Complainants moved for a pre-hearing conference in this matter to identify the issues before the Commission. Having considered the motions and all responses to these motions, the Commission finds that Grayson RECC's motions should be granted and that Complainants' motion should be denied.

Regarding Complainants' motion, the Commission finds that a pre-hearing conference for the purpose of identifying the issues in this proceeding is unnecessary. In our Order of August 1, 2005, we clearly identified the issues presented in the Complainants' Complaint that this Commission could consider. These issues were whether Grayson RECC had wrongfully discontinued Complainants' electric service on or about April 11, 2003 and whether Grayson RECC has wrongfully refused to restore Complainants' electric service by refusing to accept payment for all alleged

indebtedness or imposing additional conditions for the restoration of electric service that are not set forth in Grayson RECC's published rate schedules. Nothing that either party has submitted thus far has altered our view of the issues before us.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Grayson RECC's motion for an extension of time to respond to Commission Staff's Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents is granted. Grayson RECC's Response shall be considered as timely filed.
- 2. Grayson RECC's motion to reschedule the hearing in this matter is granted.
- 3. The hearing in this matter is rescheduled and shall begin at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, on December 20, 2005 in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.
 - 4. Complainants' Motion for a Pre-Hearing Conference is denied.
