In accordance with your letter of August 17, 2005, we are providing 10 copies of the following response and information to supplement our application:

2. Exhibit B is our statement why proposed changes could not have been included in the last rate case and why current conditions prevent deferring change until next the rate case.
3. Exhibit C – Impact Statement identifying group of customers (both existing and potential) affected by proposed change.
4. Exhibit D – Income Statement and Balance Sheet for a recent 12 month period ending June 30, 2005.
5. In compliance with 807 KAR 5:011: Section 10 (2) the additional revenue to be generated from the proposed tariff revisions will increase total revenue provided by all miscellaneous and non-recurring charges greater than 5 percent during the test year as reflected in Exhibit E - Cost Justification for Meter Installation. The absorption test is reflected in Exhibit F. No rate increase was implemented during the twelve month test period.

**STATEMENT WHY PROPOSED CHANGES
COULD NOT HAVE BEEN INCLUDED IN THE
LAST RATE CASE AND WHY CURRENT CONDITIONS
PREVENT DEFERRING CHANGE UNTIL NEXT RATE CASE**

The last general rate case was approved August 15, 2005 in PSC Case No. 2005-00299 in accordance with KRS 278-023 which does not normally cover non recurring charges. It is not anticipated that another general rate change will be necessary for several years. In order to keep the water service installation fee for 1 inch through 3 inch in line with the District's actual cost, the change should not be delayed until the next general service rate case.

The customer group impacted by the proposed change from a standard meter installation fee to an actual cost meter installation fee will be on existing and new residential and commercial customers applying for 1 inch, 1 1/2 inch, 2 inch and 3 inch size meters. In the test year ending June 30, 2005, the District received 51 applications for 1 inch meters, 0 applications for 1 1/2" inch meters, 5 applications for 2 inch meters, and 0 applications for 3 inch meters.

Notice is hereby given that the Warren County Water District has filed an application with the Public Service Commission (PSC), 211 Sower Blvd., PO Box 65, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602-0615 for the purpose of changing its charges for water service connection. The established contribution for a 5/8 inch water service connection request shall remain the same as approved and made effective August 22, 1989 in PSC Case No. 89-184: 5/8 - Inch Service Connection - \$450. The contribution for all water service installations larger than 5/8 inch shall be the actual cost of the water service connection (installation) including the cost of crossing the road and any equipment required to meet the customer's water supply needs. An estimate of the cost shall be made by the District and paid in advance by the customer prior to the installation. Any overpayment shall be refunded by the District and any underpayment shall be paid by the customer to the District. The new connect fee charges for water service installation would be effective upon approval of the PSC. Any person may file a written objection with the PSC at the above address.

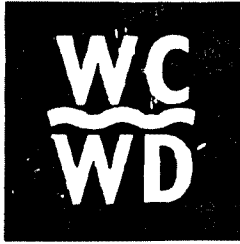

The Commission staff has reviewed your application in the above case. This filing is rejected pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 2, for the reasons set forth below. These items are either required to be filed with the application or to be referenced in the application if they are already on file in another case.

1. Filing deficiencies pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011:

807 KAR 5:011: Section 10(1)(b) Statement by utility confirming that copy of filing was simultaneously sent to the Attorney General (Attorney General has 10 days to notify PSC if he requests a hearing.)

807 KAR 5:011: Section 10(1)(c) Statement explaining why proposed changes could not have been included in last rate case and why current conditions prevent deferring change until next rate case.

807 KAR 5:011: Section 10(1)(d) Impact statement identifying group of customers (both existing and potential) affected by proposed change.

807 KAR 5:011: Section 10(1)(e) Income statement and balance sheet for a recent 12-month period.

807 KAR 5:011: Section 10(2) If the additional revenue to be generated from the proposed tariff revisions exceeds by five (5) percent the total revenues provided by all miscellaneous and non-recurring charges for a recent twelve (12) month period, the utility must file, in addition to the information set out in subsection (1)(a) of this section, the following: An absorption test showing that the additional net income generated by the tariff filing will not result in an increase in the rate of return (or other applicable valuation methods) to a level greater than that allowed in the most recent rate case. Any general rate increases received during the twelve (12) month period must be annualized. Any significant cost changes may be included but must be documented as part of the filing.

807 KAR 5:011: Section 10(3) No more than two (2) such tariff filings under this procedure shall be made between general rate cases. Additional tariff filings for non-recurring charges will be processed according to general rate case procedures.

807 KAR 5:011: Section 8 If copy of public notice is included, did it meet requirements? (For sewers, direct mailing is required. See KRS 278.185)

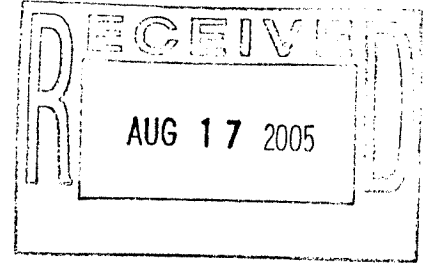
