ORDER

On October 17, 2005, Brandenburg Telephone Company ("Brandenburg") and ALEC, Inc. ("ALEC") submitted to the Commission their joint request for expedited approval of an agreement for transport and termination of Extended Area Service traffic. Their agreement was negotiated pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252.
