On October 17, 2005 our commissioners met in a regularly scheduled meeting and passed a resolution to offer free water to the city of Bremen, Kentucky, city building. At the present time only city council meetings are held in the building. There are no paid employees of the city except the city council members and the anticipated water usage is less the 1000 gallons per month. It is our understanding that the city has no revenue source other then a franchise fee from the local cable company. While we do not intend to make it a policy to offer free water to county and city facilities we feel this is an unusual situation.

Due to the situation we are uncertain as to how to go about getting the approval of the Public Service Commission. If we need to file a complete package with your office and publish it in the newspaper we will, however if we can get your approval without going to that expense we would appreciate it.
