ORDER

On December 27, 2005, the Community Action Council for Lexington-Fayette, Bourbon, Harrison and Nicholas Counties, Inc. ("CAC") filed a motion requesting (1) leave to serve data requests on Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia"),<sup>1</sup> (2) an informal conference, and (3) the right to request a formal hearing or to file written comments subsequent to the informal conference. In support of its motion, CAC states that its intervention was granted only two days prior to the date, December 9, 2005, established for issuing data requests to Columbia by our December 2, 2005 procedural Order. It also noted that its motion was filed in advance of the date established in that Order for requesting an informal conference, formal hearing, or to file written comments.

The Commission, having considered the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that CAC's motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Columbia shall respond to CAC's data requests, and serve copies on all parties to this proceeding, by January 19, 2006.

2. An informal conference shall be held on January 24, 2006, at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Conference Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

3. Any party wishing to file written comments or request a formal hearing shall do so no later than January 31, 2006. In the event written comments are filed, the parties shall have until February 10, 2006 to file reply comments.
