A proceeding similar to this case presenting the same issues is being litigated by the Parties before the North Carolina Utilities Commission, Docket No. P-55, SUB 1577, In the Matter of dPi Teleconnect, L.L.C., v. BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. The Parties have reached an agreement to abate the proceeding in Kentucky and the other BellSouth states until 30 days after a dispositive order is issued in the North Carolina case.

The parties reserve all rights, including the right to file a subsequent motion to dismiss.
