ORDER

On September 16, 2008, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Kentucky, Inc. ("AT&T Kentucky") moved the Commission to continue the formal hearing of this case scheduled for October 2, 2008. As grounds for its motion, AT&T Kentucky asserts that, during the past three years, AT&T Kentucky and dPi Teleconnect, L.L.C. ("dPi") have been involved in litigation in several states. That litigation has been overseen by AT&T Kentucky's counsel from Atlanta, J. Phillip Carver. AT&T Kentucky states that Mr. Carver is retiring effective September 30, 2008, and that new counsel will need time to address the issues of this case. dPi does not oppose this motion.
