

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the "Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 252(i), Bluegrass Telephone Co., Inc. d/b/a Kentucky Telephone Company ("KTC"), through its undersigned counsel, hereby files its Notice of Intent to adopt the currently effective interconnection agreement between Kentucky ALLTEL, Inc. ("ALLTEL") and Brandenburg Telecom, LLC.

KTC is a utility within the meaning of KRS 278.010(3)(e) and is a competitive local exchange carrier or CLEC. ALLTEL is an incumbent local exchange carrier or ILEC. KTC represents and warrants that it is an authorized provider of local telecommunications services in the state of Kentucky and that its adoption of the terms covers services in the state of Kentucky only.

The referenced agreement, which is to be adopted in its entirety, is identified by the tracking number 00768-AI on the

Commission's publicly-available Internet site for approved agreements. The CLEC party to this unexpired agreement is Brandenburg Telecom, LLC ("BBTEL"). The original ILEC party to this arbitrated agreement was Verizon South. The Commission approved the agreement in Case No. 2001-00224. Later, in Case No. 2001-00399, the Commission ordered ALLTEL to honor all interconnection agreements entered into by Verizon South.

ALLTEL acknowledges it is the successor to Verizon South and has recently amended the agreement to incorporate certain changes related to the FCC's February 4, 2005 Order on Remand in WC Docket No. 04-313. See *In the Matter of Unbundled Access to Network Elements*, 20 FCC Rcd 2533 (rel. Feb. 4, 2005) (the "TRRO"). KTC's adoption of the agreement will automatically include the recent amendments.

KTC intends to be bound by the terms of the unexpired agreement, anticipating that the terms of the agreement will be reproduced in their entirety, substituting KTC in the place of BBTEL in the Agreement. A copy of the originally approved agreement is available in the record of Case No. 2001-00224. The recent amendment to the agreement may be viewed on the PSC's public Internet site: <http://162.114.3.165/PSCICA/0000/00768/>. KTC will file copies of the agreement to be adopted if required by the Commission.

The Commission has previously acknowledged the statutory right of carriers to adopt existing interconnection agreements by notice to the Commission. As the adoption arises from a statutory right, such a request may be reviewed expeditiously and promptly granted. For example, on July 15, 2003, NuVox Communications, Inc. filed its notice of intent to adopt the negotiated interconnection agreement between Kentucky ALLTEL, Inc. and Prepaid Telecom, Inc., and requested expedited review. The Commission docketed the Notice as Case No. 2003-00303 and granted the request on August 8, 2003. Expedited review is appropriate as well for the 252(i) adoption by KTC.


KTC specifically requests that the Commission issue an order acknowledging the adoption and making the adoption effective the date of the order. This will allow for an orderly

transition to the new agreement from an existing interconnection agreement which ALLTEL has unilaterally determined to cancel.

WHEREFORE, KTC respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order:

- 1) Acknowledging the adoption by KTC;
- 2) Approving the request and making the agreement effective as of the date of the order; and
- 3) Requiring ALLTEL to file with the Commission a true and complete copy of the approved agreement.
