O R D E R

On December 22, 2005, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") and Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") jointly filed an application for approval of the construction of a transmission line in Jefferson, Bullitt, Meade, and Hardin counties, Kentucky; and, on the same date, they filed an application for approval of the construction of an alternative line in the same counties. LG&E and KU included with the applications a motion requesting that these cases, docketed as Case Nos. 2005-00467 and 2005-00472, respectively, be consolidated. Pursuant to KRS 278.020(8), "The commission shall issue its decision no later than ninety (90) days after the application is

filed, unless the commission extends this period for good cause, to one hundred twenty (120) days.”

The Commission finds that the extension authorized by KRS 278.020(8) is warranted in this case. These applications follow the application rejected in Case No. 2005-00142,<sup>1</sup> which generated significant opposition, and letters already filed with the Commission demonstrate that the opposition will continue in these certificate proceedings. For these reasons, the Commission finds that the time period in which it must issue a decision in these cases should be extended to 120 days.

The Commission further finds that these applications can be processed best by consolidating them for all administrative and procedural purposes, while retaining both case numbers. To that degree then, this Order grants the motion to consolidate.

Finally, the Commission issues a preliminary procedural schedule setting dates for certain events. The Commission reserves the right to amend this procedural schedule as needed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The time period in which the Commission must issue its decision in this case is extended to 120 days.
2. The motion to consolidate these two applications for all administrative and procedural purposes is granted.
3. The attached procedural schedule shall apply.


