O R D E R

This complaint arose from the November 25, 2005 emergency motion of Bluegrass Telephone Company, d/b/a Kentucky Telephone (“KTC”) alleging that Kentucky ALLTEL, Inc. (“ALLTEL”) was blocking certain traffic originating from KTC customers and requesting that the Commission require ALLTEL to cease blocking such traffic. ALLTEL responded to the motion, asserting that it was not currently blocking traffic. Additionally ALLTEL filed a motion to dismiss this proceeding.

KTC has notified the Commission that it has no objection to dismissal of this case without prejudice. KTC states that it is not, at this time, experiencing the problems that forced it to file the emergency motion. KTC does, however, reserve its right to seek further relief if blocking occurs in the future.

After reviewing the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that good cause exists to allow this proceeding to be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that KTC’s complaint is dismissed without prejudice and this proceeding is closed and removed from the Commission’s docket.
