COMMISSION STAFF'S INTERROGATORIES AND  
REQUESTS FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS  
TO LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Commission Staff requests that Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") file the original and 5 copies of the following information with the Commission within 10 days of the date of this request, with a copy to all parties of record. Each copy of the information requested shall be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure its legibility. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request.


1. Refer to Item 4 of the response to the Commission's December 27, 2005 Order ("December 27 Order"). For the months of May, June, July and August 2005, sales are shown to various other companies in addition to Kentucky Utilities Company

("KU") and the Midwest Independent System Operator ("MISO"). Beginning in September 2005, the only sales shown are to KU and MISO. Explain why there were no sales to companies other than KU and MISO after August of 2005.

2. Refer to Item 6, page 10 of the response to the December 27 Order. Marietta Coal Company ("Marietta") delivered only 28.7 percent of its 2005 requirements through October 31, 2005. Provide the status of the Marietta contract, including LG&E's concerns, if any, over the delivery shortfall.

3. Refer to Item 17 of the response to the December 27 Order. For the selected vendors only, provide the following information:

- a. Vendor name.
- b. Starting date and length of contract.
- c. Annual tonnage.
- d. Base price.
