

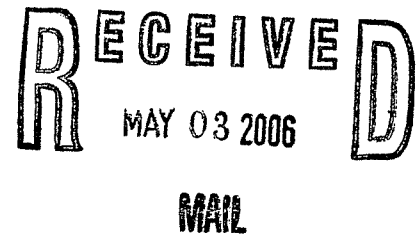

Dear Mr. Owen:

During telephone conference call on February 15, 2006, Commission Staff agreed to submit for Christian County Water District's consideration proposed revisions to the water district's present policy on easements.

Commission Staff proposes that Christian County Water District add the following provisions to its proposed tariff:

1. Christian District has the responsibility for obtaining easements and right-of-ways necessary to extend service.
2. An applicant for service may be required to provide an easement across his or her property for a water main that is necessary to provide service to his or her property. In no case, however, shall an applicant be required to obtain or provide an easement over property that he or she does not own. Christian County Water District may include the cost of obtaining easements or rights-of-way in the total per foot cost of an extension and apportioned among the utility and customer in accordance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11.


During the conference call, Christian County Water District agreed to consider revising its proposed policy on water main extensions to real estate subdivisions to conform to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11. You stated that the proposal would be brought to the attention of Christian County Water District's Board of Commissioners at an upcoming meeting. Please advise Commission Staff in writing
