This is to inform you that Farmdale Development Corporation Sewage Treatment Plant is requesting an increase in the sewer rates as follows:

Flat Monthly Residential	\$19.05	\$35.59	86.82%
Monthly Surcharge	\$ 0.00	\$27.92	N/A

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the Farmdale Development Corporation Sewage Treatment Plant. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that are higher or lower than the rates proposed in this notice.

Any corporation, association, body politic or person may request leave to intervene by motion within thirty (30) days after notice of the proposed rate changes is given. A motion to intervene shall be in writing, shall be submitted to the Executive Director, Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, P. O. Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky, 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the motion, including the status and interest of the party movant.

Upon request from an intervenor, the applicant shall furnish to the intervenor a copy of the application and supporting documents.
