On October 26, 2006, the Commission held an informal conference in this case in the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky. Present were:

Upon Farmdale Development Corporation's ("Farmdale") motion, the Commission by Order of October 20, 2006, ordered that the conference be convened.

Beginning the conference, Mr. Wuetcher stated that Commission Staff would prepare minutes of the conference for the case record, that a copy of these minutes would be provided to all parties, and that all parties would be given an opportunity to submit written comments upon those minutes.

Mr. Moore briefly discussed the procedural history of this case. He stated that Farmdale was concerned about the slow pace of the proceeding and requested the conference to ascertain the actions that Farmdale could take to facilitate a Commission decision. Mr. Moore then provided a report (Attachment 1) that Murphy's Excavating prepared on the proposed improvements and repairs to the Farmdale sewage collection and treatment facilities.

Mr. Wuetcher noted that Farmdale has been requested to provide supplier/contractor estimates to support certain elements of the proposed surcharge. These estimates must be submitted no later than November 20, 2006. After some discussion, Commission Staff stated that it anticipates its report on the proposed rate adjustment to be issued on or about December 1, 2006.

Mr. Wuetcher stated that Commission Staff may conclude that, due to the high level of certain expenditures and their effect on the life of existing sewer plant, some of the proposed actions for which the surcharge is sought may not be in the ordinary course of business and require a certificate of public convenience and necessity. In that instance, Commission Staff may recommend that a portion of the requested surcharge be denied due to the lack of any application for a certificate. Mr. Wuetcher suggested that Commission Staff may make recommendations to take into account these differing scenarios.


Mr. Kaninberg questioned how long the repairs/replacements are expected to last. Mr. Cogan responded that the proposed work should be considered a repair and should be expected to last between 35 and 40 years. and easily 30 years. Mr. Smither added that, given that the subdivision is now built out, no further problems with the sewer collection lines are expected after completion of the proposed repairs.

Ms. Pennington questioned whether the Murphy estimate contained additional items. Mr. Moore responded that the report merely explained the proposed repairs in greater detail.

The conference was then adjourned.
