

THE TARIFF FILING OF SOUTH ANDERSON WATER DISTRICT
SETTING POLICY FOR WATER MAIN EXTENSIONS TO SERVE
REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENTS
CASE NO. 2006-00118

On October 17, 2006, South Anderson Water District applied to the Public Service Commission of Kentucky for a deviation from the refunding requirements of 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11 (3). In its application, South Anderson Water District seeks relief from the obligation of making immediate refunds to real estate subdivision developers who have contributed to the cost of water distribution main extensions to serve real estate subdivisions.

Public Service Commission regulations permit South Anderson Water District to require a real estate subdivision developer to pay or finance the entire cost to extend water distribution mains to a real estate subdivision development. These regulations further require South Anderson Water District, for a period of not less than 10 years, to refund annually the cost of 50 feet of the water distribution main extension to the developer for each new customer who is directly connected to the extension. South Anderson has proposed a revision to this requirement which, while still requiring refunds to real estate subdivision developers, would limit the amount of refunds required to be made in a one-year period. The proposal would possibly lengthen the time under which the water district retains a real estate subdivision developer's deposit or otherwise makes refunds to a developer.

Any corporation, association, or person with an interest in the matter may, within thirty (30) days after publication of this notice, make written request to intervene in this matter or otherwise submit comments in writing to the Kentucky Public Service Commission. Any person who has been granted intervention by the commission may obtain copies of the application and any other filings made by the utility by contacting the utility at **142 South Main Street, P.
