SUBJECT: May 31, 2006 Informal Conference

Pursuant to the procedural schedule in the April 25, 2006 Order, an informal conference was held on May 31, 2006. Attached to this memorandum is a list of the participants. The purpose of the conference was to discuss the Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") environmental surcharge and its responses to the Staff's First Data Request.

The Staff asked Kentucky Power to discuss how it would propose to recovery the net under-recovery of \$110,756. Kentucky Power indicated it would probably favor either recovering the amount over one or two billing months. Staff indicated that this question would be included in the supplemental data request due to be issued on June 14, 2006. There was also a brief discussion concerning how the accounting for property taxes had impacted the determination of the net under-recovery during the billing periods under review.

The Attorney General ("AG") had no issues to discuss. The Staff raised the idea that if the Intervenors were satisfied with the information in the record and Kentucky Power was agreeable, the Commission would probably be willing to entertain a motion to submit the case on the record and waive a public hearing. Kentucky Power and the AG indicated they would give this approach due consideration.

The counsel for the Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC") was unable to attend the conference. Those present at the conference agreed Staff could send an e-mail to KIUC, with a copy to the other parties, briefly addressing the issues discussed at the conference. With nothing further to discuss, the conference was then adjourned. The e-mail to KIUC was sent during the afternoon of May 31, 2006.
