## <u>O R D E R</u>

The Commission's April 25, 2006 Order established a procedural schedule providing for data requests, an informal conference, and intervenor testimony. The Attorney General ("AG")<sup>1</sup> and the Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC")<sup>2</sup> submitted notices stating neither was filing testimony and, with the exception of reserving their objections to the inclusion of any costs relating to out-of-state generating facilities not qualifying for environmental surcharge recovery pursuant to KRS 278.183,<sup>3</sup> did not object to submission of the case for decision on the current record. No further events are established by the procedural schedule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Kentucky Power Company shall file, no later than 10 days from the date of this Order, a statement of whether there are any material
