ORDER

On February 16, 1999, in Case No. 1998-00499,¹ the Commission approved rates for Jefferson Gas Transmission Company ("Jefferson") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with Jefferson's gas cost adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On April 3, 2006, Jefferson filed its proposed GCA to be effective May 1, 2006.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Jefferson's notice includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.
2. Jefferson's proposed expected gas cost ("EGC") is \$6.111 per Mcf, which is 25.5 cents per Mcf less than the previous EGC of \$6.366.
3. Jefferson's notice sets out no current quarter refund adjustment.
4. Jefferson's notice sets out a current quarter actual adjustment ("AA") of (\$1.12) per Mcf. Jefferson's total AA is (\$1.1987) per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$1.178 per Mcf from the previous total AA.
5. Jefferson's GCA is \$4.9123 per Mcf, which is \$1.433 per Mcf less than the previous GCA of \$6.3453.

6. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for billing for service rendered by Jefferson on and after May 1, 2006.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are approved for billing for service rendered by Jefferson on and after May 1, 2006.
