A-3. The Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) I.D. No. 15-18869 was issued to Stillhouse Mining LLC as the Operator of Stillhouse #2 Mine. The Kentucky Mine Safety and Licensing (OMSL) No. 18631 was issued to Stillhouse Mining LLC, Operator, for Stillhouse #2. Kentucky Surface Coal Mining and Reclamation Operations Permit No. 848-5387, Revision #17, was issued April 18, 2005, to Resource Land Company LLC, with Stillhouse being the approved Operator.

Q-4. Refer to page 5 of the Matda Testimony.

a. Prior to beginning the mining operations at Stillhouse #2, was BMR or Stillhouse aware that the reserves were located in two adjacent electric service territories? Explain the response.

b. Prior to extending its distribution system an additional 500 feet to connect to the Stillhouse #2 portal, did BMR or Stillhouse contact Cumberland Valley regarding service?

A-4. a. No. BMR and Stillhouse were not aware of the dividing line between electric service territories.

b. No. Being unaware of the electric service territory dividing lines, neither K.U. nor Cumberland Valley were contacted. The reference to 500 feet was an estimate. Subsequent measurements establish the distance is 1048.2 feet.
