ORDER

- 2. Commission Staff and each party shall, no later than October 18, 2006, serve upon all other parties a list of the witnesses that it expects to call and a brief summary of each witness's expected testimony.
- 3. The parties shall file with the Commission any preliminary motions in this matter no later than October 23, 2006.
- 4. Opening statements will be permitted at the scheduled hearing in this matter, but shall not exceed 5 minutes in length.
- 5. Copies of all documents served upon any party shall be served on all other parties and filed with the Commission.

- 6. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
- 7. Service of any document or pleading shall be made in accordance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(7), and Kentucky Civil Rule 5.02.
- 8. Farmdale Development Corporation shall publish not less than 7 nor more than 21 days prior to the hearing notice in a newspaper of general circulation in Franklin County, Kentucky giving the purpose, time, place and date of hearing.
