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

REQUEST FOR INFORMAL CONFERENCE WITH STAFF

Petitioner, Blue Grass Energy Cooperative Corporation, moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission as follows:

3. That no temporary or new extension of any electrical service be permitted on a temporary basis without agreement by the parties and/or with approval of the Public Service Commission, but without prejudice to the full and final consideration of the petitions as to all issues set forth therein.

4. That the Public Service Commission issue such temporary orders as are equitable and necessary to maintain the status quo of both petitioners, without prejudice to either petitioner as to the final hearing and order in this case.


