ORDER

On September 15, 2004, Commonwealth Wastewater Systems, Inc. ("Commonwealth") filed its initial tariff following the issuance of an Order issued in Case No. 2003-00431 on June 3, 2004. The submitted tariff contained language referring to Commonwealth as a "corporation organized and engaged in business as a public utility with a state-wide service area in the Commonwealth of Kentucky." Commonwealth's tariff also states that its purpose is to "establish procedures for furnishing wastewater collection and treatment services on a uniform basis to the Company's customers within the Commonwealth of Kentucky."

The certificate of convenience and necessity approved in Case No. 2003-00431 was for a wastewater plant to serve approximately 25 residential customers in Boyle County, Kentucky.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this proceeding is hereby initiated to investigate and examine Commonwealth's tariff regarding any and all references to the provision of service to a statewide customer base.
