This firm is legal counsel to Brandenburg Telecom LLC ("BTLLC").


BTLLC hereby notifies the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (the "Commission") that Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. ("Global Crossing") has agreed to pay BTLLC's May 2006 and June 2006 invoices that were the subject of the complaint in this matter. The May 2006 invoice was for \$3531.69. The June 2006 invoice was for \$3757.12. Global Crossing has indicated that payment in full for these invoices will be made contemporaneously with the filing of this letter.

Accordingly, BTLLC respectfully requests that the Commission reserve ruling on Global Crossing's pending motion to dismiss because BTLLC is willing to withdraw its complaint upon receipt of payment in full for the May 2006 and June 2006 invoices, as described above. Upon receipt of payment in full for those invoices, BTLLC will inform the Commission of the same and formally request withdrawal of its complaint against Global Crossing.
