Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 7 **KENERGY CORP.** ("Kenergy") respectfully petitions the Commission to classify and protect as confidential the information relating to salaries and other compensation of executive officers set forth in Kenergy's response to Item 29 of the First Data Request of Commission Staff.

As grounds, petitioner states that information of this nature is exempt from disclosure under KRS 61.878(1)(a) which protects information of a personal nature where the public disclosure would constitute a clearly warranted invasion of personal privacy. The information sought to be protected as confidential obviously is of a personal nature and public disclosure would constitute an invasion of personal privacy.
