Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

Recently, upon BellSouth's request, the Commission issued an order in the above matter and specifically ordered that North American Numbering Plan Administration (NANPA) assign BellSouth the 958 NXX for the Bowling Green switch in the Bowling Green Rate Center. In the course of requesting NANPA to activate this specific NXX pursuant to the Commission's Order, however, BellSouth learned that the 958 NXX is unavailable for assignment because NANPA has designated the 958 and 959 central office codes to be used as standard test codes by the entire industry.

Based on this new information, BellSouth is notifying the Commission that it was never BellSouth's intention to overturn NANPA's decision of the assignment of an "unavailable" NXX code or to seek the PSC's assistance in doing so. There is still the need to have a dedicated code of 10,000 sequential numbers for Western Kentucky University to meet its numbering demands brought on by growth and increased administrative efficiencies and BellSouth is continuing to work with the University and NANPA to find a desirable and available code assignment. BellSouth wanted to communicate this new information to the Commission should the Commission want to revise its September 7, 2006 Order to delete the references to the specific 958 NXX.
