Pursuant to the Commission's April 12, 2007 Order, an informal conference was held on April 17, 2007 at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky. A list of the attendees is attached hereto.

The purpose of the conference was to discuss the possible resolution of all issues in this case. Inter County stated that it had reached a settlement in principle with the Attorney General, the sole intervenor in the case, and provided an overview of the settlement points. Inter County intends to present a signed settlement agreement prior to the hearing scheduled for May 15, 2007. Inter County indicated that it would be prepared to present testimony as to the reasonableness of the settlement.

Staff discussed some minor issues related to the language in Inter County's meter reading tariff and in some loan documents with East Kentucky Power Cooperative. Inter County agreed to make modifications to the documents to comply with applicable statutes and regulations. Staff requested that Inter County provide a calculation of the rate of return on rate base that results from the settlement amount, which it agreed to do.

The informal conference then adjourned.
