BellSouth under a verbal agreement between BellSouth and SCT has terminated SCT CLEC traffic via SCRTC ILEC Intra-LATA trunks. Rather than a comprehensive interconnection agreement, this is simply a trimmed down version to govern traffic exchange between BellSouth and CLECs operating in a non-competitive environment. I've included several documents:

Att 1 rates.xls -- Rates for traffic exchange
Att 2 Billing.doc -- Billing T&Cs

As I said, I'd like to work through this agreement so that we can clearly establish how our companies will exchange traffic going forward.
