JOINT MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

South Central Telcom LLC ("South Central"), by counsel, and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Kentucky ("AT&T Kentucky") (jointly, the "Parties"), by counsel, hereby jointly move the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (the "Commission") to amend the procedural schedule in this matter by continuing all currently docketed deadlines for one month.

As grounds for this motion, the Parties state that this brief extension will provide the parties with sufficient time to discuss and review their respective positions and issues implicated in this matter. These discussions may also help the parties refine their information requests with respect to the issues implicated in this matter.
