MOTION OF KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") hereby moves the Public Service Commission ("Commission") to modify the procedural schedule in this proceeding in the manner set out below to afford KU the opportunity to issue data requests concerning, and rebuttal testimony to, the testimony that Intervenor Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC"), has stated it will file in this proceeding. Allowing time for additional discovery and rebuttal testimony will also require rescheduling the hearing date in this proceeding, currently scheduled for March 14, 2007. The requested modification is necessary because KIUC has stated it intends to file testimony by March 9, after the last day for KU to file the required hearing notice. Keeping the current procedural schedule while allowing KIUC to file testimony as late as March 9 would effectively preclude KU from having the opportunity to have discovery of the testimony or rebut it if KU determines to do so.
