## Response of Windstream Kentucky East, Inc. to Commission's Order Dated November 13, 2007

Windstream Kentucky East, Inc. for its Response<sup>1</sup> to the Commission's November 13, 2007 Order in this proceeding states:

1. Ordering Paragraph 3 of the Commission's Order requested that Windstream provide a "cost-support study for the new local transit traffic rates" submitted on December 1, 2006 and approved by the Kentucky Public Service Commission on December 16, 2006. While reserving all rights under the statute as noted in its pleadings in this matter, Windstream provides the attached Appendix A.

- 2. Further, Ordering Paragraph 4 requested that Windstream present a status report noting the (a)"details on the alleged outstanding payments owed by each RLEC for tandem transit rates and end office transit rates, for costs accumulated since December 16, 2006" and (b)"details on any negotiated agreements reached or pending between the parties regarding local transit traffic service". In Appendix B, Windstream has provided the detail of outstanding amounts owed by each RLEC from June 2007 through November 2007 and the estimated total due since December 2006. In Appendix C, Windstream has attached correspondence evidencing its continuing attempt to engage the RLECs in negotiation of agreements . . The RLECs failed or refused to negotiate, and Windstream began rendering formal invoices under the transit traffic tariff with the June 2007 billing cycle.
- 3. As Windstream stated at paragraph 21 of its January 26, 2007 filing in this matter, Windstream "has a preference for negotiations and has made that fact clear to the Rural ILECs." Nevertheless, to date, the RLECs have not responded to Windstream's attempts to engage in negotiations.
- 4. Windstream, again, states for the record its willingness to negotiate agreements with the RLECs for local transit traffic. It should be noted again that several of the complainants maintain CLEC affiliates that compete in Windstream's certificated area. These CLECs have interconnection agreements with Windstream addressing the provision of and compensation for local transit traffic.

Wherefore, Windstream Kentucky East, Inc. respectfully requests the Commission accept this Response in full satisfaction of the Commission's November 13, 2007 Order.
