
Dear Sir:

Reference your letter of January 24, 2007 concerning the subject case to Mr. W. Randall Jones of Rubin & Hays.

Your letter refers to new construction. This project is not new construction. This project is for the water district to buy radio read meters and going (themselves) throughout the District pulling out **existing** meters and installing new radio read meters.

As the District's design engineer, W. Randall Jones has asked me to prepare a "system distribution map" showing you where the **existing** lines are in their system and subsequently where these radio read meters will be installed. Mr. Jones got this instruction from James D. Rice of your staff. Please be reminded that the Big Sandy Water District covers portions of Boyd, Lawrence and Carter counties. Therefore a 1" = 2 mile scale is not practical. We have prepared and enclosed herewith (3) three copies of distribution maps at 1" = 4000' for a truly useful document.


