The Commission staff has reviewed your application in the above case. This filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below.

1. Filing deficiencies pursuant to 870 KAR 5:001:

807 KAR 5:001: Section 11(1)(b) If Bonds or Notes or Other Indebtedness is proposed: Whether the debt is to be secured and if so a description of how it's secured.

807 KAR 5:001: Section 11(2)(c) If property to be acquired: Detailed estimates by USOA account number.

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above mentioned information is filed with the Commission. If your filing contains a proposed effective date, the rejection of your filing for reasons of deficiencies voids that proposed effective date. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies, you may refile your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is at least 30 days from the date you file the required information. You are requested to file 10 copies of this information within 15 days of this letter. If you need further assistance, please contact Scott Lawless at 502/564-3940 ext. 239.

Response to the above requests will complete the filing requirements of your application. To ensure the expeditious processing of your application also respond the the following requests:

1. Provide all bids received by Nebo Water District for the proposed tank painting.
2. Explain why Nebo Water District proposed to finance this tank painting instead of using funds on hand.
