Dear Reader:

This letter is in response to the Commission's or dated March 20, 2007 regarding appearance at a hearing in opposition to the proposed Cell Facility.

I would like to request that the commission consider any, some, or all of the following requests related to a "suitable and acceptable site." I am a private citizen who does not have immediate access to the type of technical information required for a cell facility or what other tracts of land may be available without considerable expense and time. Certainly, I cannot undertake to locate, hire an expert and have a report produced, nor can I produce a listing of available properties within ten days of this order. I sincerely request that the commission consider granting any or all of the following items:

1. Require Cellco to furnish a complete listing of potential sites studied for location of this facility including all technical and monetary considerations. I would like this to include a listing of all "experts" and their addresses consulted for this project.
2. Require Cellco to furnish a complete listing of any and all persons or firms which are qualified to provide appropriate technical information for alternate sites. Without this information I believe it will take me additional time to properly locate a list of persons and firms qualified to undertake such a task.
3. Require Cellco to fund (perhaps up to a limit) the payment for these alternative site studies.
4. I would like the Commission to recognize that even with the location of suitable technical expertise and funding for such a study it may be impossible in a practical sense to find a consultant who would be willing to propose alternative sites when presumable their livelihood is dependent upon future business with cell facility operators.

5. Require Cellco to provide information regarding why existing cell facilities located within what I estimate to be 500 yards of the proposed cell facility cannot be used for these purposes. I understand that the Commission has a long standing practice of now allowing "duplication of facilities." Why would a cell tower be allowed to built so close to an existing one?
6. I have an extended vacation scheduled very close to the proposed hearing date and even if I were to locate an expert, hire them and have them produce a study within so short of a time period I would find it difficult to attend a meeting on the date, particularly so far away. It will also take considerable time to research through the PVA office and realtors the availability of alternative sites once a list of technical sites is developed. I would like to request an extension of at least 180 days from the original proposed hearing date. I would also like to request that the hearing be at a location closer to the facility in question.
7. Require Cellco to furnish details of the planned facility, specifically whether the proposed facility is to be a free standing or wire tethered facility. If the proposed facility is not a free standing facility require Cellco to furnish an estimate for a free standing design.

Thank you so much for your help in this matter.
