<u>O R D E R</u>

Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation ("Jackson Purchase") has moved the Commission, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(i), to use an abbreviated form of newspaper notice to advise the public of its proposed rate adjustment. In support of its motion, Jackson Purchase states that, as part of its rate adjustment application, it plans to amend its entire tariff consisting of approximately 136 pages and that it has been informed by the local newspaper that publication of the new proposed tariff would cost between \$12,000 and \$16,000. Jackson Purchase provided the Commission with a copy of the abbreviated notice it proposes to publish.

Having reviewed the motion and the proposed notice and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the proposed notice contains sufficient information to notify Jackson Purchase's customers of the proposed rate changes, contains a Web site that its customers may access to view the entire proposed tariff, and contains a coupon that its customers may use to obtain a copy of the entire proposed tariff by mail. The Commission finds, therefore, that Jackson Purchase's motion to use the abbreviated notice should be approved. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Jackson Purchase's motion is granted.
