Dear Mrs. O'Donnell:

By Order dated October 4, 2007, Commissioner Clark is "voluntarily" refraining from participation in Case No. 2007-00143, a Kentucky-American Water Company rate case. Stating that the "public interest is best served" by so doing, Commissioner Clark advised all parties that she no is longer involved in that proceeding. However, no similar order has been entered in this case.
