**KENTUCKY-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY'S
IDENTIFICATION OF REBUTTAL WITNESSES**

In accordance with Paragraph No. 6(c) of the Commission's January 16, 2008 Order in this matter, Kentucky-American Water Company ("KAW") identifies the following individuals who may be called to provide rebuttal evidence at the March 5, 2008 evidentiary hearing and provides the accompanying brief description of the nature of their testimony.

1. Linda Bridwell. Ms. Bridwell may be called to provide verbal rebuttal testimony on the topics of: (1) the need for the facilities that are the subject of KAW's Application; (2) the adequacy of Pool 3 of the Kentucky River; (3) KAW's demand projections; (4) the feasibility of Louisville Water Company's ("LWC") idea in solving KAW's source of supply and treatment plant capacity deficits, including the feasibility of that portion of LWC's idea utilizing Frankfort and Versailles to temporarily increase available water to KAW; (5) the inaccuracies in Mr. Heitzman's February 11, 2008 Supplemental Testimony; and (6) the inaccuracies in Mr. Solomon's February 11, 2008 Direct Testimony.

2. Richard C. Svindland. Mr. Svindland may be called to provide verbal rebuttal testimony on the topics of: (1) the adequacy of Pool 3 of the Kentucky River; (2) the feasibility of LWC's idea in solving KAW's source of supply and treatment plant capacity deficits,

including the feasibility of that portion of LWC's idea utilizing Frankfort and Versailles to temporarily increase available water to KAW; and (3) the inaccuracies in Mr. Heitzman's February 11, 2008 Supplemental Testimony.

3. Harold Walker. Mr. Walker may be called to provide rebuttal testimony on the topics of: (1) the inaccuracies in Mr. Wetzel's February 11, 2008 Supplemental Testimony and accompanying report; and (2) the economic feasibility of LWC's idea as compared to KAW's proposal in this matter.


