Memorandum for Emergency Teleconference held on July 2, 2007

On July 2, 2007, Commission Staff held an emergency teleconference in this case in the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky. Present were Amy Dougherty, Jim Stevens, Tiffany Bowman, Kyle Willard and Eric Bowman representing Commission Staff. Present, by telephone, were John Selent and Tip Depp, counsel for North Central Telephone Cooperative ("North Central").

On June 28, 2007, North Central filed revisions to its PSC Kentucky Tariff 3, which addresses basic local exchange service. This proposed tariff includes increased rates for residential and commercial basic local service. After receiving this filing, Commission Staff scheduled an emergency teleconference with North Central, through its counsel, to determine the procedural direction for North Central's tariff filing, in light of the cooperative's notice that it would seek to file a rate application. This notice was filed on April 20, 2007.

North Central stated that it would file a letter with the Commission by July 5, 2007, outlining its position regarding the Commission's authority to approve the proposed tariff revision apart from the rate application case.

The emergency teleconference was then adjourned.
