Dear Director,

I received a letter from McBrayer, McGinnis, Leslie and Kirkland Law Office informing me that Cellco Partnership and Verizon Wireless has applied to the Public Service Commission for an application to construct and operate a cell facility. This facility will consist of a 300' tower with attached antennas and an equipment shelter located at 932 Fearing Road, Owingsville, KY. The notice was sent to me because I own residential property 1453 Fearing Road, were my son, Brandon Cline, resides. This proposed facility will be within a 500' radius of my son's home.

I wish to request an intervention of this application to Cellco and Verizon due to the listed reasons below:


- (1). the property location (932 Fearing Road is a rural residential area and will be in the midst of a number of residences.
- (2). the location is within 500' of my son's bedroom window.
- (3). I object to the visual impact this 300' tower would have on the enjoyment of my property.
- (4). I am afraid that this will cause the value of my property to decrease.
- (5). Even though there are still studies being done at this time on the fact of radiation emissions from this type of facility, it is still the unknown health hazard that concerns me.
- (6). The facility will also increase the number of lighting strikes in this area, as well as a possible hazard in winter of freezing temperatures and wind causing flying pieces of ice to damage human life and property damage.

(7). The Lessor, Staton Farms, still has numerous sites on their property to locate this facility, without having it placed right in front of residential dwellings.

(8). There is a facility being constructed at this time, by this same company, at 97 Iles Road, Salt Lick, KY 40371, which is approximately four driving miles from the proposed site at 932 Fearing Road. I feel that there is not a necessity for this facility.

I would like to request that the Public Service Commission please deny this application to Cellco Partnership and Verizon Wireless for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.
