Informal Conference

An informal conference in Case No. 2007-00276 was held April 4, 2008 at the Commission's offices. The purpose of the conference was to discuss Kentucky Power Company's ("Kentucky Power") Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC") base rate roll-in which occurred as a result of the Commission's Order in Case No. 2006-00507¹, Kentucky Power's recent 2-year FAC review case. The Attorney General ("AG") participated in the conference by telephone. A copy of the conference attendance list is attached hereto.

In January 2008, Kentucky Power changed the base fuel rate used in its FAC calculation from \$.01651 to \$.02124, which was approved as its new base fuel rate in the 2-year FAC review case. Kentucky Power stated that it failed to recognize the effect of the inherent 2-month lag in the recovery of fuel costs and that, as a result, it underrecovered fuel costs in January and February 2008. Kentucky Power provided handouts (which were provided to the AG by e-mail) that support its position.

Kentucky Power will seek to recover the \$ \$5,715,451 shortfall in revenue and asked for Staff's advice on the proper way in which to proceed. Kentucky Power also discussed its plans for avoiding a similar result in future FAC base-rate roll-ins.

The conference was adjourned with the understanding that Staff would be issuing a memorandum summarizing the conference.
