<u>O R D E R</u>

On November 13, 2007, Jackson Energy Cooperative ("Jackson Energy") tendered for filing an application requesting authority to revise its tariffs and adjust its rates. The application utilized a historic test period and proposed that the new rates become effective on December 12, 2007. The application failed to meet certain filing requirements and was rejected for filing, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 2(2), by letter dated November 21, 2007. In response to the rejection notice, Jackson Energy submitted additional information on December 6, 2007. Jackson Energy also refiled its revised tariffs and rates with a proposed effective date of January 7, 2008.¹

Based on a review of the additional information supplied by Jackson Energy, the Commission finds that the deficiencies noted in our November 21, 2007 letter have been corrected, and that Jackson Energy's application should be considered filed as of December 6, 2007.

Jackson Energy also requested a waiver from the provision of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)(s), which requires the filing of its Securities and Exchange Commission

("SEC") reports. Since Jackson Energy is not regulated by the SEC and files no such reports, this requirement is not applicable and no waiver is necessary.

Based on a review of Jackson Energy's rate application, the Commission finds that an investigation will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that the investigation cannot be completed by January 7, 2008. Therefore, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the proposed rates for 5 months.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Jackson Energy's application is considered filed as of December 6, 2007.
- 2. Pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), Jackson Energy's proposed rates are suspended from January 7, 2008, up to and including June 6, 2008.
- 3. Jackson Energy's request for a waiver to omit filing SEC reports is denied as unnecessary.
- 4. The procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed.
- 5. a. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided, with copies to all parties of record and 7 copies to the Commission.
- b. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and

belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

c. Any party shall make timely amendment to any prior responses if it

obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or,

though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.

d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part

of the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific

grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

6. Any party filing testimony shall file an original and 10 copies.

7. At any public hearing in this matter, neither opening statements nor

summarization of direct testimonies shall be permitted.

8. The Commission does not look favorably upon motions for continuance.

Consequently, motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall

be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

9. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering

further Orders in this matter.
