Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. ("Duke Kentucky") has filed a motion to correct the Commission's final Order entered on May 14, 2008. Duke Kentucky notes that the Order on page 2, paragraph 2, contains an incorrect demand-side management ("DSM") rate for non-residential customers. That paragraph states, in relevant part, as follows:

> For electric customers, Duke Kentucky's proposed factor for residential customers is \$.001416 per kWh, an increase from the current factor of \$.000449 per kWh. Duke Kentucky's proposed factor for distribution service for non-residential service customers is \$.01405 per kWh, an increase from the current factor of \$.001237 per kWh.

(Emphasis added).

Duke Kentucky states that the correct DSM rate for non-residential customers should be \$.001405 per kWh. The support for the proposed rate changes was provided in Appendix J to Duke Kentucky's application, which listed the correct tariff charge for non-residential electric distribution customers served under rates DS, DP, DT, GS-FL, EH, and SP as \$.001405 per kWh.

Having reviewed the motion, the record, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the DSM rate for non-residential customers was correctly stated in Duke Kentucky's application, but incorrectly stated in the May 14, 2008 Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, to be entered, nunc pro tunc, that Duke Kentucky's proposed factor for distribution service for non-residential service customers is \$.001405 per kWh.
