SOUTH KENTUCKY RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION'S RESPONSES TO THE COMMISSION'S INFORMATION REQUESTS CONTAINED IN ITS ORDER ENTERED MAY 1, 2008

South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("South Kentucky RECC"),

provides the following responses to the Commission's Requests for Information

contained in its order of May 1, 2008:

Question 1. Has your cooperative experienced any problems in administering its environmental surcharge pass through mechanism over the 2- year period under review in this case?

Answer: No.

- Question 2. Has your cooperative received any customer complaints regarding the environmental surcharge pass through mechanism during the 2-year period under review in this case?
- Answer: Our Cooperative has not received any formal complaints about the environmental surcharge pass through mechanism. We have received numerous general complaints or inquiries about the charge and its amount. South Kentucky did not record the number of these complaints.

- Question 3. Does your Cooperative believe that its environmental surcharge pass through mechanism has operated reasonably over the 2-year period under review in this case?
- Answer: No. As currently developed and applied, the mechanism for computing the environmental surcharge to customers on Special Contracts, who have special wholesale rates, currently pay less on their retail rates than South Kentucky RECC pays East Kentucky Power on the wholesale rates for the environmental surcharge.

The mechanism should be based on a per KWH charge instead of a percent of revenue from sales, which includes customer charges, demand charges, energy charges, and fuel adjustment charges.

- Question 4. Does your cooperative have any recommended changes for its existing environmental surcharge pass through mechanism?
- Answer: A change is needed as listed in the response to Item 3 so that the basis for the charges to wholesale customers is the same as retail customers. The wholesale and retail classes of customers should not differ so other rate classes do not have to subsidize special contracts.

The environmental surcharge should be based only on the energy that is consumed.

The solution of this condition would be best resolved at the wholesale level since this mechanism was developed and applied at the wholesale level.
