- 1. Refer to Item 2(a) of the response to the Commission Staff's October 17, 2007 data request.
- a. Explain why Gasco did not have a copy of the Commission's Order in Case No. 2002-00426 (Purchased Gas of Gasco Distribution Systems, Inc.), its most recent Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA") filing prior to the current filing, in its office files.

The order could not be located in our files. It is unknown if the order was not received from the Commission or if it was misplaced.

b. If Gasco did not receive a Commission Order for Case No. 2002-00426 within the amount of time it typically requires the Commission to process a GCA filing, explain why Gasco did not inquire at the Commission regarding the status of its application.

It was an oversight by Gasco, others in the office were not aware of the filing, and did not know to look for that order.

The total rates identified as those posted since December 6, 2007 are the same as the total rates posted prior to that date, although the GCR component after December 6 is roughly \$3.40 per Mcf greater than the prior GCR. Explain whether this is an error only in the data response or if the incorrect total rates have been posted on the Website.

This is an error in the data response for Item 9(a), the correct total rates were posted on Gasco's Website. The correct total rates for Residential and Commercial are \$13.2275 per Mcf and \$12.2275 per Mcf respectively.
