This letter is in response to your correspondence received October 24, 2007, regarding the above referenced case. Your letter is being treated as an official protest and will be placed in the case file of this proceeding. The Commission will take your concerns into consideration in its review and decision in this matter.


If you wish to participate further in this proceeding, you must specifically request the Commission in writing, to grant you either limited or full intervention. With limited intervention you will be entitled to the same rights as a party with full intervention except you will not be sent copies of documents submitted by other parties.

In order to be granted intervention you must show in writing either a special interest in the proceeding which is not otherwise adequately represented, or that your intervention is likely to present issues or to develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. If you desire to request either full or limited intervention, your request must be submitted to the Commission as early in the case as possible or otherwise risk being found to be untimely.

I would like to protest the increase of the sewer rate. We have lived in Farmdale for 4 years now and this seems to be an ongoing issue. We are not satisfied with the quality of the water either. In the four years we have lived there we have received two letters stating that the water contains cancer causing agents and it states that the level are not high enough to effect us, however don't give this water to infants or elderly people. Also, if we were to drink this water over a 20-30 year period who is to say that it won't cause damage to my husband or me? We now have an infant and are out even more cost because we will not allow her to consume any of this water; therefore we buy bottled water to substitute. We ourselves have stopped drinking it too after the second letter. When I called to complain all I got was someone saying it was no concern, then why were the letters sent out? Our sewer already increased this past summer and I feel it is extremely high now I cannot imagine another increase. We just feel this is ridiculous and something needs to be done about the water and the extreme rising costs of the sewer.
